thing else that comes along that is OK within itself, there are those who will choose to misuse it.

Periodically, Bonnie will show me posts that she has found to be inappropriate. She is concerned because they were posted by Christians. There are those who show no discretion in what they post and how it may be perceived by others. Some air their “dirty laundry” on Facebook. Some post things that they think are hu-
morous, but they are crude and coarse. Some post photos that are vulgar. Some use the language of the street. We expect such from the world. But as Christians we have been called to a higher stand-
ard.


When the apostle Paul was admonishing the Ephesian Christians to be “imitators of God” he said, *“But among you there must not be a hint of sexual immorality, or of any kind of impuri-
ty...because these are improper for God’s holy people. Nor should there be obscenity, foolish talk or coarse joking, which are out of place...(Eph. 5:3-4 NIV).”* “Think before you post” is sound advice for every Christian. We all know that what is sent out can never be recalled! May our postings never contradict our profession of Christ.
